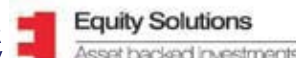

Grades

Grades as published in the most recent ECF listing will be used for this tournament. Tournament results will be submitted for grading. Rapid play grades will be used where possible.

Ungraded players

Players without a grade in the ECF are very welcome to enter, but must give details of any previously held grading, or current grading from another body e.g. Yorkshire, NW ELO. Ungraded players are eligible to win all prizes except the grading prizes. Ungraded juniors are also eligible to win one of the junior prizes
