Successful challengers will receive a café voucher for either a coffee or ice cream. A donation of £3 per game is requested for which both players will have 5 minutes playing time for the game. However, should the challenger wish to buy time from their opponent to improve their chances an additional two minutes are available for £1 per minute. All proceeds will go to the British Red Cross.
