Wanstead House is a short distance from both the Redbridge roundabout on the A406 (North Circular Road) and the Green Man roundabout on the A12 and easily assessable from the M11, M25 and A13 as well as central, north and east London. Tournament Rules

1. The FIDE rules of Blitz chess will be used.
2. Only players with a published ECF grade will be able to win a grading prize. The grade used will be the most recent X-E standard play grade. If no standard play grade then a rapid-play grade will be used.
3. The grading prizes will be determined on the night based on the entries.
4. To claim a win of time/mate the claiming player's flag must be up at the time of the claim. If both flags are found to have fallen then the game is drawn, regardless on whose flag fell first.
5. Use of excessive force when using the clock will result in the automatic loss of the game.
6. Mobile phones and other electronic means of communication must be turned off in the playing hall
7. The organisers reserve the right to increase/decrease the prize fund depending on the number of entries
8. The decision of the Tournament Director is final
